

Terms, Acknowledgment and Release For Rocky River Fall Arts Festival

Saturday, September 19, 10 a.m.-5 p.m.

In consideration of acceptance as an exhibitor of the Rocky River Fall Arts Festival, I hereby agree to the following terms, rules, and releases:

- I do hereby release, hold harmless and forever discharge the City of Rocky River from any and all actions, claims and demands for any damage, loss, or injury, of whatsoever kind of nature, arising from, and by reason of any and all known and unknown, foreseen and unforeseen bodily and personal injuries, damage to any property, including, but not limited to, any equipment, personal property or any items in storage, and the consequences thereof, incurred by me, the above exhibitor and assigns of same, resulting from participation in the Rocky River Fall Arts Festival.
- I further agree to give a right of indemnification to the City of Rocky River for any such occurrences, injuries, losses or damages incurred during the period of use and occupancy of the premises by me or my organization.
- I further acknowledge that there are no booth fees of any kind this year as this is the first Fall Arts Festival for the City of Rocky River. The City is only asking that participants donate one item of their choice to raffle off during the preview party on September 18th to benefit the Rocky River Parks & Recreation Foundation.
- I further acknowledge that all exhibitors will be responsible for taking care of his/her own sales receipts, collecting sales tax (7.75%), and obtaining a current Ohio Transient Vendor's License. (www.tax.ohio.gov)
- I further acknowledge that exhibitors must carry their own insurance to cover the value of their work. City of Rocky River assumes no liability for damage, theft or injury on premises.
- I further acknowledge that exhibitor must be present at all times during the event. Booth space is limited to 10 x 10. Participants are required to provide their own tent, tables, chairs, displays, etc. Participants should be prepared to secure their tent and displays in the case of wind and/or rain.
- I further acknowledge that the art committee reserves the right to require removal of items they judge to be inappropriate. All paintings, drawings, graphics must be framed, matted or displayed tastefully.
- I further acknowledge that all work exhibited must be original, designed and produced by, or under the direct supervision of the exhibiting artist. All work must be priced and signed by the artist.
- I further acknowledge receipt of a copy of this Terms, Acknowledgment and Release for participation in the Rocky River Fall Arts Festival.
