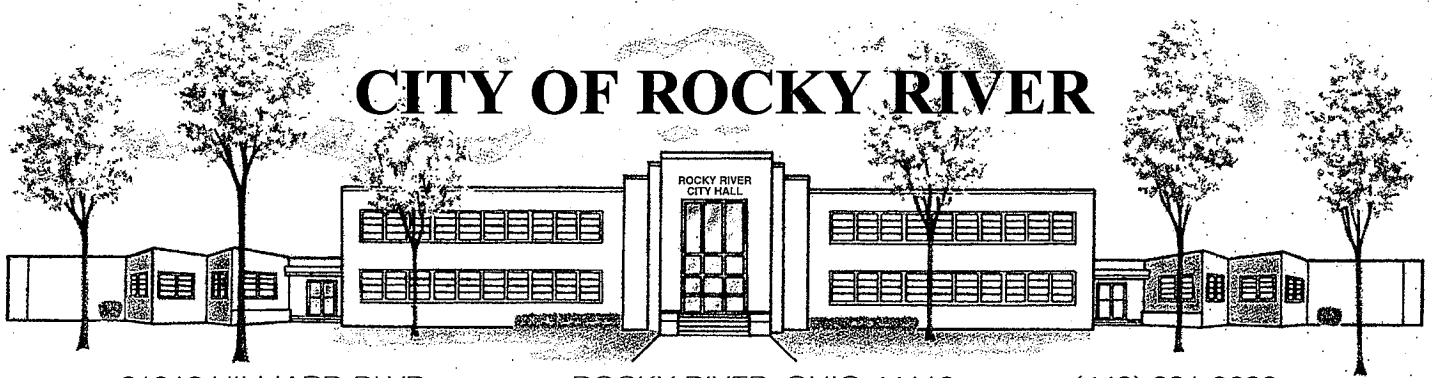

Dear Owner / Resident:

Preparation for Lake Road paving has been underway and pre-paving / sub-grade concrete road work has begun. The final paving work will require the Ohio Department of Transportation and their contractor to close the Lake Road intersections at Argyle and Cornwall. As of Monday, April 18, 2011, these intersections will be closed for approximately one month depending on weather conditions. The Ohio Department of Transportation and their contractor have determined that in order to expedite the paving process it is necessary to close the Argyle and Cornwall intersections at Lake Road.

Due to this final paving process there will be no access through the construction zone from Argyle and Cornwall at Lake Road. The Kensington and Falmouth / Avalon intersections will remain open at Lake Road during this process. Also, access to the intersections of Argyle and Cornwall at Beachcliff Boulevard will remain open. Existing directional signage at Beachcliff Boulevard and the Argyle and Cornwall intersections will be moved to direct traffic towards the marginal that leads to Lake Road. Every effort will be made to maintain accessibility to the Lake Road businesses during this paving process. However, please expect increased truck traffic and extended delays in the westbound traffic lane on Lake Road for some portions of the final paving process.

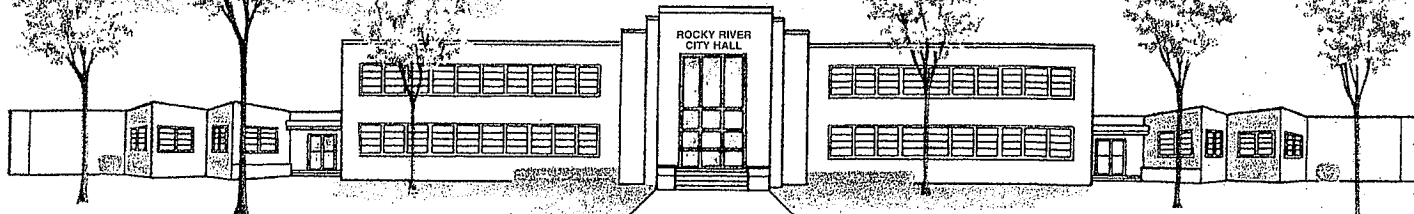

Dear Lake Road Residents and Business Owners:

The Ohio Department of Transportation and their contractor have completed the sewer replacement portion of the project and most of the underground work along Lake Road. Remaining underground work on utilities and sub-grade road work in the construction area is nearly complete also. Despite challenges due to weather, this project is staying ahead of its anticipated schedule. We remain cautiously optimistic that this project will remain ahead of schedule.

Preparation for Lake Road paving has been underway. Pre-paving / sub-grade concrete road work has begun and will be completed after the remaining underground work is completed. Paving work in the construction zone is anticipated to begin the end of April if weather cooperates. During the paving process work to improve the intersection of Elmwood and Lake Road will begin and that intersection will be paved as part of this project. What day paving occurs will be dependant upon weather conditions.

The paving process will involve many, large trucks transporting concrete to sections of the street and these trucks will be using the west bound lane while delivering the concrete paving product. The construction trucks will often be stopped in the westbound roadway which will cause extended delays and at times this will completely block traffic in the Lake Road westbound lane. This part of the paving process will take at least two days, weather permitting. Once the concrete is cured asphalt will be applied. Once the date for the start of this process is known, we will alert the businesses and residences along this portion of Lake Road.

We will continue maintain updates on the City website and will send city-wide e-mail messages as part of the "Stay Loyal to Lake Road" efforts. Dear Residents, Property and Business Owners:

On behalf of the Ohio Department of Transportation, the City of Rocky River and contractor DiGioia-Suburban Excavating, LCC, please be advised that beginning on March 9, 2011 crews will begin the restoration phase of the project to repair U.S. 6 (Lake Road) in the City of Rocky River.

Beginning March 9, 2011 U.S. 6 (Lake Road) between Morewood Parkway and Linda Street will be closed to eastbound traffic until the completion of the project. Eastbound motorists will be detoured via Detroit Road. Truck traffic may utilize Linda Street to access the businesses on Lake Road while eastbound traffic is restricted. Westbound traffic will be maintained.

The underground work is completed. During the remainder of the project crews will replace the existing pavement and install new driveway aprons and sidewalks on U.S. 6 (Lake Road) between Lind Street and Morewood Parkway and reconstruct the intersection of Lake Road and Elmwood Road.

Work will take place four to five days a week Monday through Friday – 7 a.m. to 5:30 p.m.
