725.01 PERMIT REQUIRED.

Any person desiring to operate a circus or outdoor amusement concession or carnival in the City shall first obtain a permit to do so from the Director of Public Safety-Service.

725.02 LOCATION NEAR RESIDENCES RESTRICTED.

A permit for such circus, carnival or like outdoor amusement concession shall not be granted unless the grounds of operation are not less than fifteen hundred (1500) lineal feet from the nearest adjacent home or other residential building.

725.03 TERM OF PERMIT; RESTRICTIONS.

No permit to operate shall be granted for a period of more than three (3) continuous calendar days in one (1) month at one (1) location.

725.04 FEE.

A fee shall be paid for each permit wherein live animals, power-driven concessions and/or amusement rides and devices are to be operated. Such fee shall be in accordance with Section 1321.05 of the Codified Ordinances and is intended to defray the expenses of City inspections and supervision.

725.05 DEPOSIT REQUIRED.

When granted the permit, the applicant shall, at that time, also make a deposit as set forth in Section 1321.05 of the Codified Ordinances with the Department of Public Safety-Service as a guarantee that the grounds of operation will be cleaned of all rubbish and debris immediately after such circus, carnival or other outdoor amusement concession permit has expired.

725.06 LOUD SPEAKERS RESTRICTED.

Mechanical music using a loud speaker or similar amplification methods shall cease and be turned off not later than 10:00 p.m. each night.

725.07 HOURS OF OPERATION.

The hours of operation are hereby limited to commence no sooner than 2:00 p.m. and continue not later than 11:00 p.m., at which time all activities shall cease, including the artificial lighting of the grounds.

725.99 PENALTY.

Whoever violates any provision of this Chapter shall be guilty of a minor misdemeanor for the first offense. Whoever violates any provision of this Chapter shall be guilty of a fourth degree misdemeanor for the second offense or subsequent offenses.
